JOB SEEKERS WITH DISABILITIES

The Employment Links Project can assist you in connecting with employers to achieve employment that matches your skills and abilities

You may qualify if you

- Have a documented disability that creates barriers to finding and/or keeping employment
- Live in the Edmonton area and are able to independently get to OSP and the worksite
- Have a realistic employment goal that matches your skills and abilities
- Are not receiving employment services from any other agencies
- Are READY, WILLING and ABLE to find and maintain employment

Prepare for work

- WORKSHOPS offered daily
- EMPLOYER and COMMUNITY LINKS sessions once a week
- JOB TRYOUTS
- INFORMATIONAL INTERVIEWS and JOB SHADOWS

Develop employment credentials

- Access EXPOSURE COURSES at vocational institutions for certification required to obtain employment
- OSP offers WHMIS and First Aid

Find work

- JOB SEARCH RESOURCES available as you seek work
- JOB SEARCH GROUP offered three times per week
- EMPLOYMENT SPECIALISTS make contact with Employers on your behalf
- One-on-one meetings to ASSIST in your job search planning

Workplace training

- Clients with little or no employment experience can access Employer training at the job site
- Employers provide TRAINING THROUGH A TRAINING SUBSIDY
- Eligibility determined by program staff

Maintain work

- OSP can provide Employer education and assist with workplace ACCOMMODATIONS
- OSP provides intensive three month JOB RETENTION SUPPORTS
- Total of six months FOLLOW UP ensures you and your Employer have support when needed
