Temporary Workers are:

Unable to maintain permanent employment as a result of a disability

Able to provide documentation of their disability

Open to disclosing disability related information to host employers

Only seeking temporary employment

Eligible to work in Canada and over 18 years of age

Living in Edmonton and area

Not currently receiving employment services from any other agencies

Not attending a full time educational program

Able to attend to personal life management issues

AGENCY SERVICES

Workers have a range of services available to enhance and support temporary assignments:

Employability Assessments

Case Management and temporary placement services

Job Coaching, Monitoring and Follow-up supports

Job accommodations coordinated with host employers, workers and temporary employment agency staff

Work Exposure Courses and Workshops enhance employability and life management skills

Learning Supports provided during workshops and exposure courses

AGENCY OUTCOMES

Temporary workers are considered for temporary assignments that match their abilities.

Individuals build self confidence, stamina and readiness for employment.

Local Edmonton and area employers find a valuable pool of workers to meet their temporary employment needs.
